


The Association FRAGAS was founded in memory of the biologist Paula Tavares, killed in a tragic road accident caused by others. Fragas also pays tribute to Agata Sousa, an environmental engineer killed in the same accident.

Paula Tavares was born on the 3rd of November in 1972 in Almada (Pragal). She was a biologist and researcher at the Instituto Superior Tecnico in Lisbon. Paula had a PhD in ecotoxicology and was carrying out extensive research in the subject. As a social ecologist as well, she was involved in activism in the fields of environmental protection, agroecology, food sovereignty and fair trade. She was notable for defending cultural values, associateship and community action. A woman of many dreams, projects and causes, Paula took part from a young age in several struggles and demonstrations for women's rights.
